# IV. SRA Report

- 2019 Registrations DRAs be aware:
  - No credit for leaving early from re-cert
  - o DRA responsibility to distribute badges via whatever means
  - o GO Roster has "Badge Received" checkbox only for SRA use
  - o Michael has Velcro discs Please ask if you need additional

## • AGM

- 1<sup>st</sup> weekend of November is available at Radisson Rochester Airport (Nov 1-3)
- o Asked hotel to hold space until we finalize
- We want to compile a video/slide presentation to show accomplishments of our referees
- Assessment fee collection
  - Most reaction from referees has been positive
- Directors are set to attend workshop in Chicago
- Potential Grade changes in 2020

- State Assessor course none being offered. Trying to get State Coach courses, but only one offered in 2019 (Atlanta). No materials available
- Batavia Registrations: Referees will change district when they select a recert. There will be recert clinics scheduled for either Dansville or Mount Morris. Buffalo has not seen any Batavia registrations. Rochester as seen a few.
- Buffalo House League referees working winter games need to be registered for 2019

## V. SYRA Report (Campbell)

- Frank Giancroce has been replaced by Steve Mauricio as Region 1 Referee Administrator
- Proposal:
  - Travel allowance amount for ODP/Regional for any drivers (\$131/person ODP, \$180/person Regionals) to even out lost stipends as in past. Is committee supportive to spend money to send referees to these tournaments
  - Previously, there have been benefits to referee careers. Going forward, that is doubtful
  - There is a need for adult supervision of youth referees at these tournaments (Head of Delegation has been eliminated)
  - o Bianchi Should we continue to send referees to these tournaments?
  - Serrano Should we redirect funds to send our referees to other events (DA, etc...)?
  - Tata we should table until April. Campbell If we table until April, it will be dead for this year
  - o Ross Consider providing National Coaches to referees at State Cup
  - Paparo Continue sending potential candidate names to SYRA regardless of which events we choose. Campbell – Yes.
- Motion (Ross): Recruit/fund National Referee Coaches from other states to attend State Cup for an amount under \$10,000.00.
  - o Second Pasnak

- o Approved unanimously
- o Tom will approach Rick Eddy for next steps

# VI. SDI Report (Ross)

- Changing classes GO problem with changing classes and double charging referees. DRAs can make these changes manually in GameOfficials
- If referees have difficulty accessing tests, likely because they did not complete a previous section
- Going to Chicago 1 on 1 scheduled with staff from OfficialsConnect to discuss transition from GO
- Next year recerts Rochester/Buffalo please work to schedule some clinics in Batavia/Livingston County
- Upgrade clinic Held in November. Must be taken within 1 year of upgrade year. Any who plan to upgrade for 2020 and have not taken, they must complete this November
- AGM
  - Spoken to Kris Bailey (AL) to put together sessions for less experienced referees
  - Working on schedule
  - o Trying to get Rick Eddy in to explain grade changes
  - Trying to get someone from OfficialsConnect (will be registration platform for 2020)
- Registration for assessors/instructors Grade 6 or 7 referee test transfers but must still complete section 1 acknowledgements for assessor/instructors

#### VII. SDA Report (Jaspe)

- 34 returning assessors
- 2020 recert must attend advanced referee recert with assessment portion completed on-line
- Assessors may continue to do D&G assessments without SDA approval and should be compensated per local board policy

# VIII. SCA Report (Pasnak)

 Assignor class – Scheduled for February, currently 6 participants. Districts should contact Pasnak ASAP with additional candidates. Time and place will be determined soon – Likely Rochester will be location

## IX. Binghamton

- Introduced Assistant DRA Steve Hanes
- Registrations are way down, 24-25 attended recert
- Only 3 signed up for entry level course
- Hanes: Bing/Elm/Ithaca 18 games mentored, 16 referees. 3 mentors per district, \$60 per game, total cost \$1,080.00. Plan for 2019 25-30 games, 20-30 referees, additional training for mentors. Request \$2,000.00 for the 3 districts for 2019

## X. Buffalo

- 9 recerts completed with 247 referees, 33 registered for remaining recerts. 14 acknowledged that they will not return. Currently 294 referees accounted for prior to entry level registrations. All advanced (7+) referees have been accounted for. All upgrade candidates have completed recert
- 4 entry level courses scheduled, 2 additional pending. 63 current applicants. Advertising done at schools and indoor facilities, and at adult soccer and junior league meetings.
- Ross will send out instructions for sending mass email to district referees via GO to all DRAs

  - ST no longer has an instructor, will be required to pay travel for instructors
- Positive feedback from referees and parents on mentor program
- New club joining from Pennsylvania. Need to determine how to verify PAWest Risk Management for PAWest Referees. Tata will contact PAWest SRA and try to get a list of cleared referees who work these games

## XV. Syracuse

- New President Bill Albro
- 2 recerts completed, not well attended
- 1 entry course in early February (Syracuse), 1 entry course in March (Watertown)
- Mentor program
  - o There are referees requesting mentoring
  - Select core group of mentors for intermediate referees
  - Tata Requests proposal with numbers and costs
  - o 1st & 2nd year referees covered by league funds and unit dues
  - Wolgast will work with Tata to create a rubric defining a funding proposal for mentoring, etc...
  - o Jaspe What measurements should be done beyond retention

  - Clarified that referees should be following Federation guidelines on game counts for upgrade.
  - Registration RM checkbox Only says that referees will follow RM procedures for the matches they do. This does not mean they must go through RM process
- Tata Mentor Program Requests
  - o Motion: Approve up to \$2,000.00 each for Southern Tier and Bing/Ith/Elm
    - Second Campbell
    - Approved unanimously. Funds will be made available when invoiced
- Jaspe Confirmation that no referees under the age of 18 will be assigned to adult matches. Policy is being formulated and will be published soon.
